Sunday, August 25: Karla Klay Title: To be announced

Karla Klay is the founding director of Artist Boat. Over the past 15 years, Artist Boat has served over 132,000 participants, resulting in 90,000 youth and adults paddling Texas estuaries with artists and scientists, 70 large benches beautified with art work interpreting our natural heritage on the Galveston Seawall, over 55 campuses being beautified with student-created public murals and mosaics and nativescapes, Galveston Beaches being transformed with 7 recycle centers and 200 beautified trash barrels, 55 acres of restored coastal prairies and dunes, and 669 acres being conserved on west Galveston Island.

Annually, over 10,000 participants experience direct immersion in coastal education, art education, and experiences with bay and Gulf. They create public art to educate their communities, they restore dunes and prairies, they explore and learn, they save lands, and they teach others how important it is to take good care of our water.
